

## LUCA GEMMA

Luca Gemma is an Italian indie-pop-rock singer and songwriter. His career started in the 90's in Milano with Rossomaltese, a folk-rock band that generated a very personal style in the indie Italian scene, with two albums- "Santantonio" (coproduced by Tony Bowers, bass player of the Simply Red) and "Mosche Libere"- and more than 350 gigs in Italy and France, also as opening act for Caetano Veloso and Billy Bragg.

He has been writing lots of songs for other singers, for moviesoundtracks and for national radio, tv and theatre productions.

To be mentioned also a lasting collaboration with Steve Piccolo (bassplayer and co-founder of the New York band Lounge Lizards) and Gak Sato (dj and producer from Tokyo) that brought to an album, "Expedition", in 2004, distributed in Europe and Japan.

They toured together for over 4 years collaborating also with New York guitarist and composer Elliot Sharp and many visual artists as Janine Higgins and Armin Linke.

New studio album of Luca "Tecniche di Illuminazione" is out since April 2007, follow up to his highly acclaimed first solo album "Saluti da Venus", 2004.

Luca is now on tour, both with an electric band of 5 musicians and alone for acoustic shows.

He's still working and writing songs for a radio-broadcast and will soon work for an important Italian movie.
