The Gil Evans Orchestra led by Miles Evans has performed at festivals, in concert halls, and clubs throughout the Jazz Loving World! In Italy the group was featured throughout Sicily at Jazz Festival Venues, at Umbria Jazz Winter, Orvieto, as well as Umbria Jazz summer, in Perugia on several occasions. They performed at the North Sea Festival, the Jazz Mecca, in Holland, and the Montreux Jazz Festival, as well as other Major European Jazz Festivals. They performed in Tokyo, Osaka, Madareo and other Festivals throughout Japan.

In the USA they performed the JVC Jazz Festivals, including Lincoln Center New York and the Hollywood Bowl in L.A., they performed at the Peach State Festival in Georgia, and the Montreal Festival in Canada. In South America they performed in Brazil; Rio and San Paulo. They performed at Paul Allen's Benaroya Hall, Seattle Washington as part of a Jimi Hendrix tribute. The Orchestra performed at the "Ronnie Scotts Club" in London; Sculler's Club in Boston, to name a few, all to enthusiastic audiences! They did extended performance Schedules at "Birdland" and "Sweet Basil" N.Y.C. where the recording "The Gil Evans Orchestra Live at Sweet Basil" was Grammy nominated.
